To the 4<sup>th</sup> Interrogatory or direction: My means of knowledge are derived from my personal examination of and search after the property of Defendants as Sheriff of Frederick County, under the Fieri Facias filed with Commissioners".

This Cause standing ready for hearing, and being submitted the Bill, Petitory taken and other the proceedings were read & considered. It is thereupon this 1<sup>st</sup> day of March in the year 1860 by the Hon Mc Nelson, Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, and by his Authority adjudged Ordered and Decreed, that unless the Defendants or some of them, shall on or before the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March instant, pay or bring into this Court to be paid to the Complainant the Amount of the debt and interest due to the Complainant and set forth in the Bill of Complaint, together with the Complainant's Costs of this suit, to be taxed by the Clerk, the real estate and premises in the Bill and proceedings mentioned, together with the water power and privileges thereto belonging, and appurtenant, or so much thereof as may be necessary for that purpose be sold, and that William P. Merrill be, and he is hereby appointed Trustee to make said Sale, and that the course and manner of this proceedings shall be as follows:

He shall first file with the Clerk of this Court a Bond to the State of Maryland and executed by himself with a surety or sureties to be approved by the Court or the Clerk thereof in the penalty of Ten Thousand Dollars
