To the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sub ~ He did not leave a widow ~ He was married to Caroline Brouge She is dead, she died before him, some two or three years before he died. ~

To the 4<sup>th</sup> Sub. He had Children, Sophia Korb and Thomas Korb died before Daniel Korb without leaving issue and intestate ~ He left the Children named in my answer to the first Interrogatory, the said Children are all over twenty One years of Age ~ All the Children of said Daniel Korb appear as parties to this suit ~

To the 5<sup>th</sup> Sub ~ He did leave real estate. It is a farm containing about one hundred and two acres of land, situated in Mount Pleasant District Frederick County Maryland. I look at Exhibits A + B here shown me, the land left by said Korb is the same land described in Exhibit A, except the portion described in Exhibit B.

To the 6<sup>th</sup> Sub: ~ The said land cannot be divided without loss and injury to the parties interested. It is not capable of beneficial division among the Children of said Daniel Korb, and it cannot be managed to their advantage as it is at present. ~ It would be to the advantage of all the heirs to have the said land sold, and the proceeds divided among those interested, because it is unimproved land, and if divided the portions would be too small for advantageous cultivation or sale. ~ If the land was sold and the money was invested, it would bring the heirs more than if the land was rented or cultivated. ~

Daniel Korb, Lewis A Korb of Frederick County Md., Joseph Korb and Rutha his wife of New Richmond Ohio, Daniel Korb Jr. and Naomi Urmehle, Andrew J Whitacre and Louisa K Whitacre his wife his wife of Washington City District of Columbia, Alfred B Korb and L M A Korb who reside in Frederick Co Md. They are all adults except Alfred B Korb L M A Korb who are infants under twenty one years of age, Louisa K Korb married Andrew J. Whitacre and Naomi Korb married Charles Urmehle who is now dead. ~

To the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sub. ~ I know Daniel Korb, He is dead, He has been dead since October 1841 He died in Frederick County Maryland, where he resided. He did leave a will. ~

To the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sub. ~ He did not leave a widow, his wife Caroline Brouge had been dead two or three years before he died. ~ He left Children, Sophia Korb and Thomas Korb died before Daniel Korb, without leaving issue and intestate. He left the Children named in my answer to the first interrogatory, those Children are all over twenty one years of age except L M A Korb and Alfred B Korb, both of whom are infants under twenty one years of age. All of the Children of said Daniel Korb appear as parties to this suit. ~

To the 5<sup>th</sup> Sub ~ He left real estate, consisting of a farm containing about one hundred and two acres of land situated in Mount Pleasant District Frederick County Maryland. I now look at Exhibits
