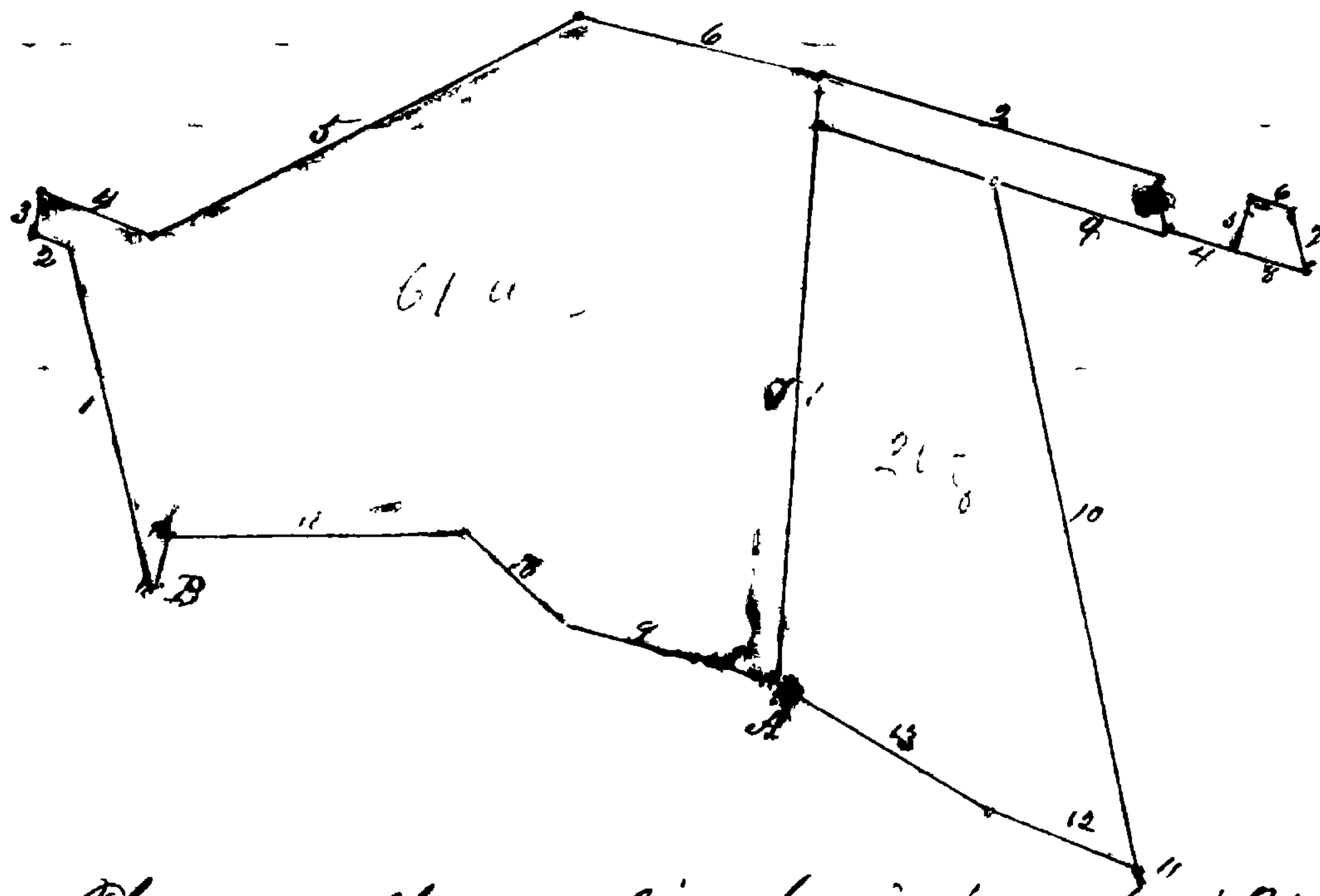

Remarks ~ The green shaded lines beginning at "B" and numbered from 1 to 12, show the part of said Farm belonging to the Estate of Daniel Kolb deceased being composed of the parts of the following named tracts of Land viz, part of a tract called "Final" and part of a tract called "Addison's Choice" which was deeded to Daniel Kolb by Joseph Stouffer. Beginning for the Outlines of said part, at a stone now set up, where formerly stood a Poplar Tree, it being the beginning of 58 Acres that was deeded by Charles Solomon to Frederick Keller dated Feb'y 5th 1825 and running thence with the closing line of said deed, correcting the same, N 48 E 58 ps intersecting the 12th line of "Final", and with it reversed correcting the same N 24 1/4 E 5 ps to the beginning of the deed from Samuel Cook to Abraham Cadet, and with the closing line reversed, correcting the same, S 86 1/4 E 7 1/2 ps. to the end of the 5th line thereof, still with said deed reversed correcting the same S 25 N 17 1/2 ps. to the end of the 13th line of Middle Plantation, and with the 14th line correcting the same S 24 1/4 N 80 ps S 37 1/2 N 45 1/2 ps.
