Be it remembered that heretofore to wit, On the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January, in the year of Our Lord, One thousand Eight hundred and seventy two, Came the said William Henry Soelkey into Court here sitting as a Court of Equity, by W. J. & C. H. Ross Esqrs his Attorneys, and filed here the following Bill with accompanying Exhibits

Bill

To the Honorable the Judges of the Fifth Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland sitting in the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity.

The Bill of Complaint of William Henry Soelkey, of the City of Baltimore State of Maryland - respectfully shews to your Honors - That a certain Frederick William - formerly a resident of Frederick County, did intestate some time in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty, seized and possessed of the following real estate, situate in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland viz. - The East half of that Lot or portion of ground designated by Lot No. 1 lying and being in the South addition to Frederick town, Frederick County Maryland, and conveyed by Edward Buckley to the said Frederick William Soelkey by deed dated on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of September Eighteen hundred and fifty two - Also all that piece or portion of ground lying and being adjacent to Frederick town in Frederick County, being a portion of ground described as follows - Beginning for the part hereby intended to be conveyed, at the South East Corner of Lot formerly owned by Edward Buckley, running Two hundred and nine feet, more or less in a southerly direction to the farm heretofore owned by Bolton Jackson's heirs, then with the line of said farm in an Easterly direction, fifty one feet to a stake then in a Northerly direction to the South East corner of said Buckley Lot Westwardly to the Beginning - Conveyed to the said Frederick William Soelkey by Peter L. Storm and wife, by deed dated the twentieth day of January, in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty four - All of which will more fully and at large appear by reference to Certified Copies of said deeds herewith Exhibited Marked Exhibits Nos. 1 & 2, which your Complainant's pray, together with all other Exhibits hereafter produced, may be taken and considered as part of this his Bill of Complaint.

Your Complainant further Charges that the said Frederick William Soelkey being indebted in his lifetime to a certain Lewis M. Nisdorff, in the sum of Five hundred and fifty dollars - And for the purpose of securing the payment of said sum of Money, and interest on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty One, in conjunction with his wife Genl Soelkey execute the Mortgage to the said Lewis M. Nisdorff - conveying all that part of the real Estate of the said Frederick William Soelkey, described in the deed from Edward Buckley to said Soelkey and Exhibited herewith as Exhibit No. 1.

And your Complainant further Charges that on the thirteenth day of August in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty two, the said Lewis M. Nisdorff assigned in writing the said Mortgage to Genl Soelkey, then the widow of the said Frederick William Soelkey who now holds and owns the said Mortgage by virtue of said Assignment in her own right all of which will fully appear by reference to a Certified Copy of said Mortgage and
