- 3<sup>rd</sup> Sub. Were you or not acquainted with the handwriting of said John A H Cunningham? If yea, look at the papers now shown you, marked respectively "Exhibit P." and "Exhibit F." (which Commissioner will please file and return with Commission) and purporting to be promissory notes from said Cunningham to Peter Thomas of G. Complainant, and state whether or not the signatures, respectively appended thereto are the signatures of said John A H Cunningham; and state the grounds of your belief?
- 4<sup>th</sup> Sub. Are you or not acquainted with the lands whereof said John A H Cunningham died seized and possessed, in said Frederick County? If yea, look at the Exhibits now shown you, Exhibits "D H," "N B" and "N O." with the Bill in this Cause, and state whether or not they accurately describe his said lands, and whether or not he died seized and possessed of the same, except that portions conveyed and described in "Exhibit N O."?
