The Petition of Daniel Baker of said County, respectfully shows that by reference to the proceedings had in the above entitled cause, it will appear that your Petitioner purchased the property decreed to be sold by James L. Davis the Trustee appointed to make said sale; that said sale was duly ratified and confirmed; and part of the purchase money was duly paid to said Trustee, and the receipt of the same reported to said Court for distribution. It will further appear that said James L. Davis as said Trustee was authorized to receive from your Petitioner as said purchaser such amount as your Petitioner might be willing to pay of the purchase money in advance of period for the payment of the deferred instalments, and that your Petitioner has paid ten thousand dollars of the purchase money, leaving a balance of Ten thousand dollars, with a due proportion of interest yet unpaid ~ That on the payment of the whole purchase money, said Trustee was directed to execute a good and sufficient deed of said property to your Petitioner, free and discharged of all claim of the parties to said cause. ~
