I give, devise and bequeath to my wife Jane Le Norris for and during her life the farm conveyed to me by Andrew and John J. Boyd Executors of the will of David Boyd, also the houses and lots now occupied by me situated on Patrick Street Frederick ~ also twenty shares of the Stock of the Bank of Baltimore standing in my name ~ Also two bonds of the State of Maryland of Five hundred dollars each, bearing six per cent interest, Also seven Bonds of the State of Missouri of One thousand dollars each ~ And at and after her death I give, devise and bequeath such real and personal Estate, to the children of my daughter Eleanor Jane Trego, then living. ~

All the rest and residue of my Estate, real, personal and mixed of which I die seized or possessed, I give, devise and bequeath to my wife Jane Le Norris ~ And lastly I constitute and appoint my wife Jane Le Norris to be sole Executrix of this my last will hereby revoking all former wills by me made.
