Ross Esqrs and filed here the following Bill of Complaint with the Exhibits thereon mentioned. ~

Bill of Complaint

To the Honorable the Judges of the Sixth Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland, sitting in the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity.
The Bill of Complaint of J Hampton Taylor of Frederick County State of Maryland, respectfully shews to your Honors - that by Articles of agreement dated on the 21st day of November in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy, entered into between your Complainant and a certain Patrick Kelley of the town of Emmittsburg, Frederick County County. ~ Your Complainant sold to the said Kelley - certain Lots and parts of Lots, situate in the town of Emmittsburg, Frederick County aforesaid - And being all that Lots and those two half lots of ground with the improvements thereon made or erected, and situate on the North side of Main Street, and on the east side of the Public square in the town of Emmittsburg, and known as the East half of Lot No. - the whole of Lot No. - and the Western half of Lot No. in the Plat of said town - adjoining Lot of James F Adelsburger on the west, and lot of heirs of James Kerrigan Jr dead, on the East, and extending from Main Street on the South to an alley on the North - And being the same lots and parts of lots of ground conveyed by John K Taylor to the said J Hampton Taylor, by deed dated on the 21st day of September 1840, and recorded in Liber L.M. No 5. folio 653 One of the Land Records of Frederick County, a Copy of which said deed is herewith Exhibited
