This Deed, made this 21st day of September in the year 1870, by one John K Taylor of Frederick County in the State of Maryland: Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand dollars I the said John K Taylor, do grant unto James H Taylor, of the County and State aforesaid, in fee simple, all the following described lots and parts of lots of land situate lying and being on the North side of the Main Street in the Town of Emmittsburg, Frederick County State of Maryland, and designated on the plat of said Emmittsburg as "Lot No 7," and the West half of "Lot No 6," and also a part of "Lot No 5," on the Main Street, and running back the same width to an Alley, and being the same lot and parts of lots of ground and premises, which was conveyed to the said John K Taylor by deed from Daniel & Adelsberger, Mary M Adelsberger his wife, bearing date on the 23rd day of May in the year 1870, and recorded in Liber 6 W.
