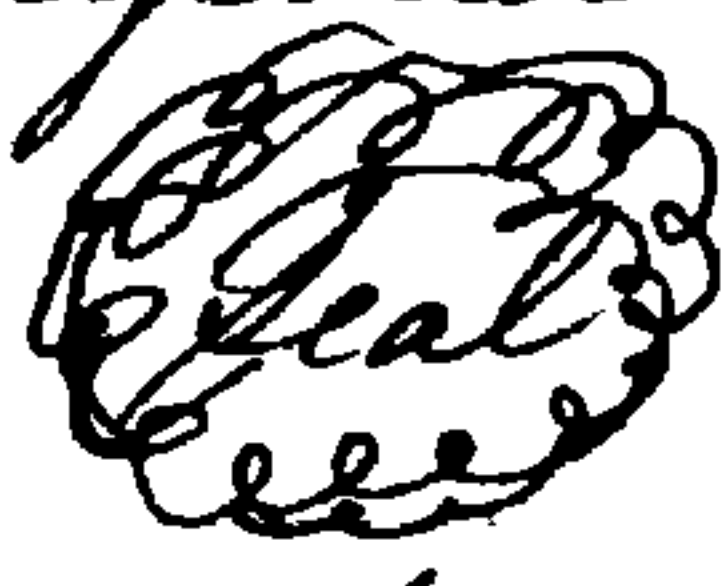

Be it known, that you are appointed Commissioners to examine Eviden-
