That he is acquainted with all the parties to this suit, that their names are as follows, viz. of Hampton Taylor, Mary Kelly, Frances Kelly, Catharine, Anna, Lewis and Regina Kelly, who reside in Frederick County, Md. Henry M. Souch, who resides in the state of Pennsylvania, Paul Flynn, and Emma R. Flynn, his wife, and William Kelly, who reside in Juncosville, Clearfield County Pennsylvania, all adults except William, Lewis and Regina Kelly, who are infants under the age of twenty one years. ~

2nd Int. That he was acquainted with Patrick Kelly, that he is dead, that he died in Frederick County, Maryland, during the month of February, Eighteen Hundred and Seventy two; that he left a widow named Mary J. Kelly and the following children, namely; Emma R. married to Paul Flynn; Francis, Catharine, Anna, William, Lewis and Regina Kelly, who are infants under the age of twenty one years, and all residing in Frederick County, Maryland, except William Kelly and Emma R. Flynn, who reside in the state of Pennsylvania. ~

3rd Int. ~ Waived as to this Deponent. ~

4th Int. That he has seen Patrick Kelly write, and knows his handwriting, that he has never seen of Hampton Taylor write, and is not acquainted with his handwriting; That he looks at "Exhibit No 2" now here shown him, and that the signature "Patrick Kelly" thereto attached is in the proper handwriting of the said Patrick Kelly. ~

5th Int. That he knows the lands described in "Exhibit No 2"; that they are situated in the town of Emmittsburg, Frederick County, Maryland, and consist of one whole lot and two half lots, as laid out on the Map of said Town, situated and fronting on the Main Street of said town, One Hundred and fifteen feet and seven inches, with a depth of One Hundred feet, That he looks at "Exhibit No 1" now here shown him, and that the lands there in described, are the same as are described in said "Exhibit No 2".

6th Int. That he did - that he took possession of said lands, described in "Exhibit No 2", on the first day of April, Eighteen Hundred and Seventy One, and remained in possession thereof until the day of his death, that Mary J. Kelly, his widow, is now in possession thereof. That said Patrick Kelly improved said lands, by erecting a Brick Store House thereon, containing Store room fixtures &c. ~

7th Int. ~ That said Patrick Kelly never had said purchase money, nor any part thereof. ~

8th Int. That he knows nothing more than he has already testified to in his answers to the foregoing interrogatories. ~
