The above cause standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted
the Bill, Answers, Interlocutory Decree, Order of Publication, Exhibits, Depositions
and all other proceedings were by the Court read and Considered

It is thereupon this 20th day of November in the year Eighteen Hundred and
Seventy two, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, a Court of Equity, &c
& by the authority thereof, ordered, adjudged and decreed, that the defendant, the
Executors at law of Patrick Kelly late of Frederick County State of Maryland deceased
forthwith pay, or bring into this Court to be paid to said Complainant the sum
of Seventeen Hundred dollars, part of the purchase money due before the filing of
this Bill, with interest thereon from the first day of April in the year Eighteen
Hundred and Seventy one, until so paid or brought in, and further execute their
note for thirteen hundred dollars with interest from the first day of April
1871, to be secured by Mortgage on said premises and costs of suit, to be taxed
by the Clerk. And that upon payment of said sum of money with interest
as aforesaid, and upon the execution of a note for Thirteen hundred dollars with
interest from the first day of April 1871 payable in two years from said
first day of April 1871 with interest thereon secured by mortgage on said
premises, the Complainant by a good and sufficient deed to be executed and
acknowledged according to law, shall convey unto the Defendants, the heirs
at law of said Patrick Kelly deceased, the land and premises described
in these proceedings as sold by said Complainant to said Patrick Kelly
subject to the Mechanic's Lien, if any, of said Henry M. Schumock.
And it is further adjudged ordered and decreed, that unless the said de-
fendants shall pay or bring into this Court to be paid to said Complainant
