In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this thirteenth day of August, in the year of Our Lord, One thousand Eight hundred and Sixty seven.

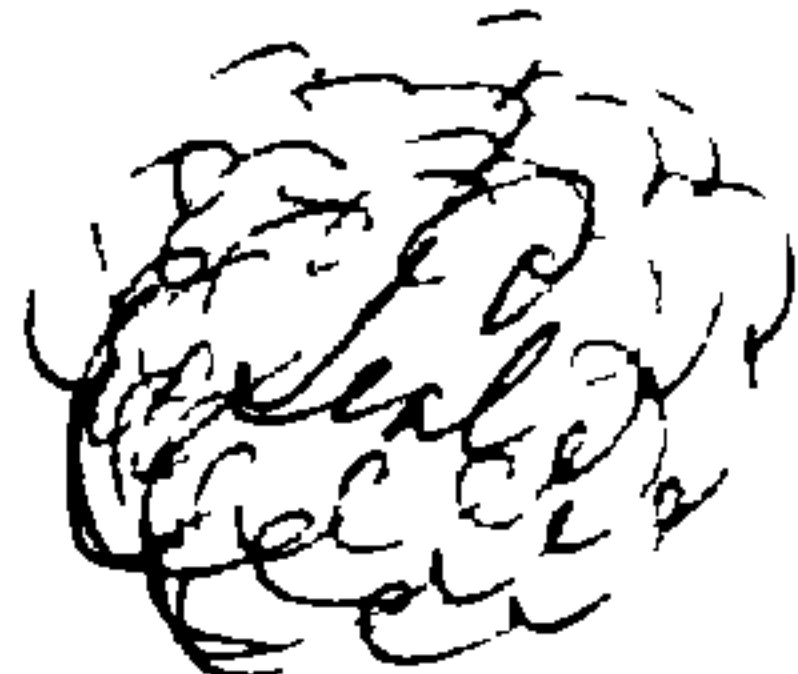
