



I Seth A Nichols, of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, do make and publish, this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following, that is to say, - After the payment of my just debts and funeral charges, I give, devise and bequeath, all the rest and residue of my Estate, real, personal and mixed, of every sort, kind and description whatever, unto my wife Mary M. Nichols, for and during her natural life and no longer, the same being for her support and the support and education of our children, and at the death of my above said Wife then the whole of my Estate as above described or as much thereof as shall be remaining, - I give, devise and bequeath to my Children equally, share and share alike, and should any of the said Children die in the mean time leaving a Child or Children then such Child or Children, is to have and receive such part or portion of my Estate as it or their deceased parent would have been entitled to if living: - I hereby further authorize and empower my wife, to sell the dwelling House and lot of ground thereto belonging, situate on the North side of Patrick Street on the City of Frederick, on which I now reside, if she shall think it for the better for herself and our children, and either to purchase another ^{smaller} house and lot of ground out of said purchase money, and invest the needed or balance of said moneys in some safe investment, or rent a comfortable dwelling house for herself and
