Testimony

At the execution of the Annexed Commission, issued out of the Circuit Court, for Frederick County, and to us directed, and empowering us to examine witnesses in the Cause therein depending, between Samuel Eicholtz, as Complainant, and George Baker and others as Defendants. We William D Nelson & John E R Wood Commissioners therein named, did, on the Seventeenth day of December A.D. one thousand and seventy-two, at the Office of William D. Nelson Esq^r. in Frederick City, Maryland, then and there, proceed to take the following testimony, to wit:—

The Complainant filed with the Commissioners as evidence Exhibits Nos 1 2 3 4 5 6 & 7, which are herewith returned by said Commissioners: And there being no witnesses present to be examined and further time being required for the production of Evidence, the said Commission was adjourned to the twenty-third day of December Eighteen Hundred and Seventy-two, at which time and at the place aforesaid, We then and there, proceeded to take the following depositions, to wit:—
