Order of Partition John Stollenmeyer and Susan Stollenmeyer his wife vs Jacob Redenour and Rebecca Redenour his wife, Susan Stollenmeyer and Others

No 3816 Equity

In the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting in Equity.

The Object of this Bill is to obtain a decree for the sale of the real estate mentioned in these proceedings for the purpose of partition among the complainants and defendants - who claim as Coparceners.

The Bill states that George Stollenmeyer by his last will - After the payment of Funeral Expenses, debts, and a small legacy devised all his Estate Real and personal to his wife, Susan Stollenmeyer, for her use for life, and with power to dispose of the same by deed or will or otherwise and made no disposition of the same, on the failure of his wife Susan Stollenmeyer to execute the power under said Will. That said George Stollenmeyer died in September Eighteen hundred and Seventy one, seized and possessed in fee of certain Tracts of Land, being part of the "Resurvey on Almost Night" and "Peace" Lots in Frederick County State of Maryland, containing Acres of all Conveyances made by George Stollenmeyer in his lifetime, Twenty five Acres of Land More or less.

That Susan Stollenmeyer the wife and devisee of George Stollenmeyer took possession of the estate devised and bequeathed to her by her husband, and died in the month of Eighteen hundred and Seventy two, without having disposed of said lands by deed, will or otherwise, and that the real estate rested in the children and heirs of said George Stollenmeyer as Coparceners or tenants in Common - That the said George Stollenmeyer had by his wife's children, the only children of the said George and Susan Stollenmeyer his wife to wit:

John Stollenmeyer, Cecilia, now wife of Jacob Redenour; Susan Stollenmeyer Margaret now wife of Henry Redenour, Samuel Stollenmeyer and Abram Stollenmeyer. Only children of George Stollenmeyer, who died before his father, George Stollenmeyer son and Mahala Blenness, who died before her father the said George Stollenmeyer son, leaving children and heirs unknown to Complainants

The Bill further states that the said lands cannot be divided without loss or injury to the parties interested, and prays for a sale, for the purpose of partition - It is therefore adjudged, ordered that the complainants by causing a copy of this Order to be inserted in some newspaper published
