To the Honorable the Judges of the Sixth Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland, sitting in the Circuit for Frederick County as a Court of Equity The Bell of Complaint of John Wilson Sr, Henry R Harris, George F B Cumberbaugh and Josiah A Zimmerman, of Frederick County State of Maryland shows that a certain Henry M Straelman and Catharine R Straelman his wife of Frederick County, and State of Maryland, to indemnify John Wilson as surety in a promissory note to Mrs Ellen Nelson for one thousand dollars dated October 5th 1864 payable twelve months after date, with interest from date, in which note said John Nelson and one Adam Custard was sureties, and also to indemnify George F B Cumberbaugh, and said John Wilson Sr, on a note date Nov 6, 1871, payable sixty days after date to the Frederick County National Bank in the sum of one thousand dollars in which note said George F B Cumberbaugh and said John Wilson, Sr, are sureties and to indemnify said John Wilson Sr and Josiah Zimmerman in a note to The Frederick County Nation Bank in the sum of four hundred dollars, payable ninety days after date and dated on the 25th day of November 1871, in which note the said John Wilson, Sr, and Josiah P Zimmerman are sureties and to indemnify Henry
