### No 3626 Equity

Bill

To the Honorable the Judges of the Sixth Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland, sitting in the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity. The Bill of Complaint of the Frederick County National Bank, a body corporate under and by virtue of an act of Congress of the United States approved June 3rd 1864, respectfully shows to your Honor that a certain James Giddings, of Frederick County, State of Maryland by his promissory note dated on the 29th day of January, in the year Eighteen hundred and Eighty three, payable to John H Williams, or order six months after date in the sum of Thirty five hundred Dollars, and by said John H Williams, Cashier, endorsed to the President and Directors of the Frederick County Bank stood indebted to the Frederick County Bank in the sum of money in said promissory note recited, and intending to secure the payment of the said sum of money in said note recited at maturity or if renewed to pay any note in renewal thereof at maturity when thereto demanded, the said James Giddings did by his deed of Mortgage dated on the 29th day of January, in the year 1868, convey to the President and Directors of the Frederick County Bank all the following pieces or parts of tracts of land, situated in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland called "Corruption" "The Home Shoe" "Fieldela Manor" and "Guns Delight, containing, clear of all encumbrances heretofore made by said James Giddings, Four hundred and one acres of land, more or less, and to which said deed there is a condition annexed "That if the said James Giddings shall pay to the said President and Directors of the Frederick County Bank, the said sum of Thirty five hundred dollars in said note specified at the maturity thereof if payment thereof be demanded or if from time to time renewed shall pay any notes or note in renewal thereof at the maturity thereof when payment thereof shall be demanded by the said President, and Directors of the Frederick County Bank, and shall also pay all interest due thereon then this Mortgage shall be void" all which will more fully and at large appear by reference to a certified copy of said deed of Mortgage hereinafter Exhibited, marked Exhibit No 1, which your complainant prays together with all other Exhibits hereinafter produced may be taken and
