Will of Joshua  
Dell

A true extract from the last Will of Joshua Dell late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased

In the name of God, Amen I Joshua Dell of Frederick City & County, in the State of Maryland, being in good health & of sound & disposing mind, memory and understanding, do therefore make and publish this my last will and testament, in manner and form, that is to say First and principal, I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the earth, and after my debts are paid I devise and bequeath as follows First, I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Dell all my real, personal and mixed property of every sort, kind and description, to be hers during her life or widowhood And lastly, I do order and direct that after my debts and legacies are paid the balance of my estate if any shall be equal divided among my heirs or their heirs and the share coming to John F Dell is to go to his Trustees in the same manner that the other is and after the death of the said John F Dell the trust funds is to be equal divided among the lawful heirs of the said John F Dell I do hereby constitute and appoint my sons Lewis H George J John F and George R Wyong and Theodore Shultz my Executors of this my last will and testament, with full power to sell and convey any or all my real and personal estate at private or public sale, ratifying and confirming this my last will and testament and none other In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 15th day of May 1861
