

deceit right of Mrs Juliet C Thomas, and further admit that Wm A Thomas one of the sons and heirs at law of said Samuel Thomasly decd conveyed the same to Joshua Hall, that Joshua Hall now dead by his Will duly executed to pass real estate, devised all his estate to his wife Mary Hall for life, and after his death devised all the residue of his estate to his children, the portion intended for his son John F to be held in trust during his life and after his death to his children These defendants further admit that Mary Hall widow and devisee after life of Joshua Hall is dead, and that the undivided interest in said lands passed under the residuary clause of the Will of said Joshua Hall to his children, that the said John F Hall and his children are entitled to one fifth of said portion George F Hall to one fifth thereof, Lewis H Hall to one fifth thereof, the children of Bennetta Wyong a daughter now deceased to-wit Mary, now wife of Speches Hill, Eliza Wyong and William Wyong to one fifth thereof The children of Mary M Shultz wife of Theodore Shultz and which said Mary died before her father Joshua Hall to-wit Bennetta Shultz, Sophia H Shultz and Mary M Shultz to one fifth thereof These defendants further admit that William Wyong, Bennetta, Sophia H and Mary M Shultz are infants under the age of twenty one years These defendants further admit that the said lands cannot be divided without loss or injury to the parties interested and consent and agree that a decree may pass for the sale of the same and the proceeds to be divided among the parties according to their several interests
