This Deed made this 10th day of November, in the year 1860, by Goven Blanchard Philpot of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland. Witnesseth that in consideration of Two hundred Dollars, the said Goven B Philpot, doth grant unto Ann West Philpot of the said County and State all his interest and share portion and estate, being the one undivided ninth part (in fee simple) of all those parts, pieces or parcels of land called "Resurvey or 'Maryland' and 'Fieldens Manor,'" lying and being in Frederick County, and State of Maryland, aforesaid, of which the late Brian Philpot, the father of said Goven B Philpot, died, seized and possessed, and which are more particularly described by their metes and bounds in a deed of conveyance from Mountgory B Luskett and Thomas Johnson, Trustees to Benedict Boone, dated the 8th day of April, 1850, and recorded in Liber W B T No 11 folio 247 or one of the Land Records of Frederick County and which were purchased by the said Benedict Boone for the use and benefit of the said Brian Philpot and which were subsequently conveyed by the said Benedict Boone and Sarah Boone his wife, to John Reed, John Philpot and others heirs at law of the said Brian Philpot by deed dated the 14th day of October - and recorded in Liber B G F No 4 folio 158 or one of the Land Records of Frederick County, and the said Goven B Philpot covenants that he will execute such further assurances as may be necessary. 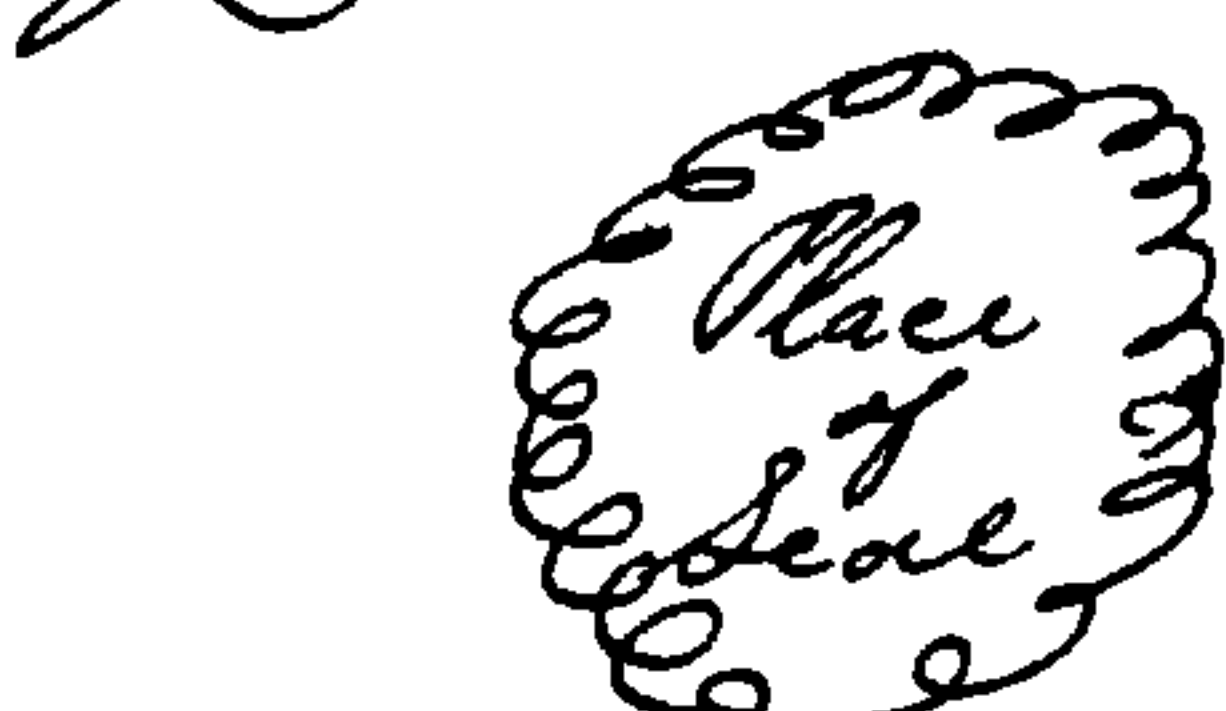
