 orator for a valuable consideration by assignment-in writing under
 the hand and seal of said Samuel Flegle of C, as will appear by refer-
 ence to the assignment-on the back of said Mortgage and notes, And
 your Orator further charges that-the first of said notes Exhibit A, being for
 the sum of \$1000. became due and payable on the first day of April in the
 year 1871, and that the same was not paid, nor the interest thereon, nor any
 part thereof, but that-the whole of said to-wit: the sum of \$1000. with inter-
 est thereon from April 1st 1870 is now due and unpaid to your Orator, nor
 has any part thereof been paid to the said Samuel Flegle of C, but that-the
 whole of said sum remains due and owing as aforesaid, And your Orator furth-
 er charges that-the said notes marked Exhibit B and C are not yet due
 but your Orator charges that no part of the principal sum named therein
 nor of the interest thereon may have been paid either to the said Samuel Flegle of C,
 or to your Orator, but that-the whole of said sums remains owing
 and unpaid. And your Orator further charges that-the said Edward Men-
 schoff departed this life some time about-the month of December in the
 year 1871, leaving a last-Will and Testament-under and by which the
 herein before named Catharine Menschoff was appointed sole Executrix
 of said last-Will and Testament, and who has entered upon the discharge
 of her said trust, and leaving as his heirs at Law, a certain Edward Menschoff
 his son, and a certain Catharine Hoffman his daughter who before the
 death of said Edward had intermarried with a certain Henry Hoffman
 and a certain Jackson Hoffman and Edward Hoffman grandchildren
 of the said Edward Menschoff decd, who are the children of a certain
 Elizabeth Hoffman the daughter of the said Edward Menschoff and who
 before the death of said Edward had intermarried with the said Henry
 Hoffman and departed this life before the death of the said Edward, And your
 Orator charges that the said Catharine Menschoff Executrix, Catharine
 Hoffman, Henry Hoffman and Edward Menschoff are adults, and
 that-the said Jackson Hoffman and Edward Hoffman are infants under
 Twenty-One years of age, and all said parties are residents of the State of
 Maryland. And your Orator further charges that-the personal Estate
 of the said Edward Menschoff decd, is utterly inadequate to the payment of
 his debts, and that your Orator is remediless in the premises without the aid
 of your Honourable Court, And your Orator files herewith a certified copy of the
 said Will of Edward Menschoff decd, and of the letters of administration granted
 to the said Catharine Menschoff Executrix which are marked respectively Exhib-
 its J and K. To the end therefore that-the said Catharine Menschoff Executrix
 of the last Will and Testament of Edward Menschoff deceased, Edward Men-
 schoff, Catharine Hoffman, Henry Hoffman, Jackson Hoffman and
 Edward Hoffman may answer the several matters and things herein
 before stated as fully and particularly as if they were herein again repeated
 and they were thereunto specially interrogated, and that-the lands and
 premises herein before mentioned or as much thereof as may be necessary
 may be sold for the payment of your Orator's claim with interest as
 aforesaid, And that your Orator may have such further and other
 relief as his case may require, May it please your Honours to grant
 unto your Orator the writs of Subpoena against the said Catharine
