Testimony

At the execution of the annexed Commission, issued out of the Circuit Court for Frederick County and to me directed and empowering me to examine evidences in the cause therein depending between Andrew Arman as Complainant and Catharins Wenschhoff and others as Defendants, I William B Nelson Commissioner therein named, did on the 8th day of March Eighteen hundred and Seventy two, at the Court House in Frederick City, Maryland, then and there proceed in the presence of the Solicitor for the Complainant, to take the following testimony to wit: The Complainant filed with the Commissioner as evidence Exhibits A B C D E and F which are herewith returned by said Commissioner. Anthony McBride a witness of lawful age, produced upon the part of the Complainant, being duly sworn and examined to interrogatories filed with the Commissioner by the Complainant and herewith returned deposes and says to the 1st Int. That he was acquainted with Edward Wenschhoff, that he is dead that he died a little more than a year ago, that he left a widow and two children Edward Wenschhoff and Catharine wife of Henry Hoffman and two grandchildren Jackson and Edward children of a deceased daughter Elizabeth Hoffman and that they all reside in Frederick County Maryland. To 2nd Int. That he knew Samuel Flegle, that he has seen him write, that he looks at Exhibits A B C and D and the signatures of Samuel Flegle thereon and that he believes said signatures to be in the proper handwriting of the said Samuel Flegle. To 3^d Int. That Edward Wenschhoff died seized and possessed of the Real Estate in Exhibit D mentioned. To 4th Int. That he died seized of some personal Estate, but he does not know of any personal Estate sufficient to pay his debts, including the Mortgage debt mentioned and to the best of his knowledge he did not. To 5th Int. That he knows nothing further. There being no other witnesses present to be examined and no further time being required for the production of evidence the Commissioner closed the said commission, and herewith returned the same under his hand and seal this ninth day of March Eighteen hundred and Seventy two.
