Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity.

The Petition of Antureck Jack of Frederick

County and State of Maryland, respectfully represents unto your Honors in behalf of himself and all other creditors of Abdul Magers deceased, late of said County, who may convene and contribute to the expenses of this Petition, that the said Abdul Magers was in his lifetime indebted to your Petitioner on a promissory note in the sum of Forty dollars and Eleven cents and on other account in the sum of One hundred and Seventeen dollars and Sixty cents as will appear from said note and account duly proved and passed by the Orphans Court for Frederick County, herewith filed marked Exhibit Band B. which Exhibit with all other Exhibits hereinafter produced by your Petitioner, he prays may be taken and considered as part of this Petition, and that said sums of money are still due and unpaid. Your Petitioner further alleges and charges that the personal Estate of the said deceased is wholly insufficient to pay his debts, as will appear from a certified copy of appraisement of ~~the~~ ^{the} personal effects of said deceased, together with a certified copy of the list of debts proved, passed and filed in the Orphans Court for Frederick County herewith filed as Exhibit Band C. Your Petitioner further alleges and represents that on the 1st day of April, in the year Eighteen hundred and Seventy two, the said Abdul Magers died intestate leaving a sister Mary Ann Stansbury, and the heirs of Suranda Galligher a deceased sister, as his only heirs at Law, that the said Mary Ann Stansbury resides in Carroll County, in the State of Maryland, and the name and residences (if living) of the heirs of the said Suranda Galligher are unknown to your Petitioner, saving Edward Galligher a son of the said Suranda Galligher, who is a non-resident of the State of Maryland. Your Petitioner further alleges and charges that the said Abdul Magers died seized and possessed of certain Real Estate, lying and being in Frederick County and State of Maryland, and that on the 3rd day of December 1872, a bill was filed in your Honorable Court (and in which case it is prayed the Petition may be filed) by the said Mary Ann Stansbury for the sale of said Real Estate and a division of the proceeds of said sale among three entitled thereto, that a decree was passed by your Honors ordering the sale of said Real Estate, and that the same was sold for the sum of seven hundred and ninety three dollars by Nicholas Stansbury Trustee, appointed by your Honorable Court to make the sale, all of which will appear by reference to the proceedings above referred to, and the said sum has not yet been distributed among the heirs at Law of the said Abdul Magers, deceased. Your Petitioner therefore prays your Honors to pass an order in said case, directing
