

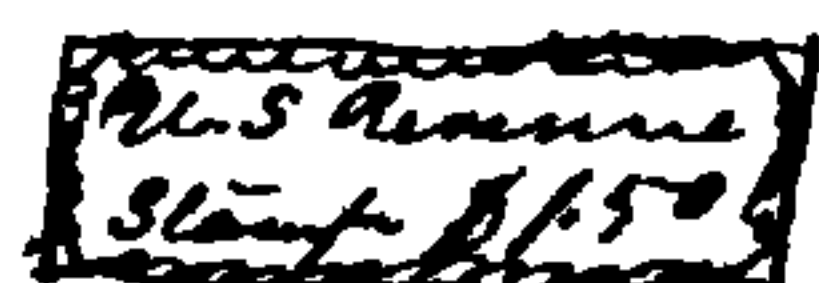

This Deed made this 25<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty six by Ezra S Marker and Elizabeth Marker his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesses that in consideration of Eleven hundred dollars the said Ezra S Marker and Elizabeth Marker his wife do grant unto Catharine Lumbough of the County and State aforesaid all the following two Lots of ground situated in the County of Frederick which are described as follows, Being both parts of an original tract of Land called "New Saxony" Beginning for the outlines of the first Lot hereby intended to be conveyed at a stone standing in the Public Road leading to Beallsville the same being the beginning of the 6<sup>th</sup> line of the deed from Adam Boutzahn to a certain Daniel Mann then running with said 6<sup>th</sup> line and the Public Road North 61° West 44 1/4 fms then North 23° East 10 1/2 fms to a stake North 73° East 7 1/2 fms to a stake North 7° West 1 1/2 fms to the beginning of the 3<sup>d</sup> line of said Deed of Boutzahn to Mann then with said Deed three courses and distances viz North 87 1/2 East 21 fms South 19° East 26 1/2 fms South 12° West 11 1/2 fms to the place of beginning, containing Five Acres One rood and Two perches of Land more or less.
