This Mortgage made this 29th day of April in the year 1869 by Richard W Holland of Frederick County, State of Maryland Witnesseth that I the said Richard W Holland by my two single Bills bearing date on the 1st day of April in the year 1869 each for the sum of Twenty Five hundred dollars and payable respectively One and Two years after date with interest from date payable semi-annually stand indebted unto George Smith Executor of the last Will and Testament of John J Smith deceased in the sum of Five Thousand dollars being the balance of the purchase money for the Real Estate conveyed by the said George Smith Executor to the said Richard W Holland by deed bearing like date and executed simultaneously with these presents and to secure to the said George Smith Executor the payment of the said sum of Five Thousand dollars with the interest thereon semi-annually according to the tenor & effect of the two single Bills above recited. I the said Richard W Holland do grant unto the said George Smith Executor all that half lot or portion of ground situate lying and being in Frederick Town, Frederick County, State of Maryland known and distinguished on the plat or plan of said Town by number 29 and fronting on Patrick Street 20 feet and running southerly ending on Public Alley 365 feet more or less being the premises known as the "Central Hotel" and being the same half lot or portion of ground which was conveyed by the said George Smith Executor to the said Richard W Holland by deed bearing like date and executed simultaneously with these presents, provided that if I the said Richard W Holland shall pay to the said George Smith Executor the said sum of Five Thousand dollars with the interest thereon semi-annually according to the tenor & effect
