Exhibit 6. This Mortgage made this 19th day of December in the year 1872 by me Daniel M. Reese of Baltimore City, State of Maryland, Witnesseth whereas, I the said Daniel M. Reese by my Five single Bills all dated on the 19th day of December in the year 1872, and payable respectively on or before the 1st day of April in the year 1873, 1874, 1875, 1876 and 1877 to Joshua Biggs or order the first of the sum of Five Thousand dollars with interest from date and each and all the other single Bills for the sum of One Thousand dollars with interest from date the interest payable annually on each and every single Bill stand indebted to the said Joshua Biggs in the said sums of money in said single Bills recited and for the purpose of securing the payments of said single Bills as they respectively become due and payable together with the interest that may accrue thereon the interest to be paid annually on each of said single Bills according to the tenor and effect thereof and which said sums of Money recited in said single Bills, I the said Daniel M. Reese acknowledge to have received at the time of the execution of this Mortgage, I the said Daniel M. Reese have agreed to execute these presents. Now therefore in consideration of the above recited premises I the said Daniel M. Reese do grant unto the said Joshua Biggs all that part of a tract of Land called "Benjamin Adams" situate in Frederick County, State of Md. containing 29 acres of Land more or less, also part of a tract of Land called "Promous Dwelling" containing One and a half acres of Land more or less together with all and singular the Buildings, improvements, Privileges, Advantages Roads Ways Water, Water courses and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining it being the same Land conveyed to the said Daniel M. Reese by Joshua Biggs by deed dated on the 19th day of December in the year 1872 and recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County. Provided that if I the said Daniel M. Reese, my heirs executors or administrators shall pay to the said Joshua Biggs his executors administrators or assigns the said sums of money in said single Bills recited together with the interest due thereon the interest to be paid annually on each and every single Bill when the same shall become due and payable according to the tenor and effect thereof then this Mortgage shall be void. Provided further that if default shall be made in the payment of the sums of money recited in said single Bills or anyone of them when the same shall become due and payable according to the tenor and effect thereof or if default shall be made in the payment of the interest on any of said single Bills the interest to be paid annually on each and every single Bill according to the tenor and effect thereof and in failure to comply with anyone of the conditions and provisions of this Mortgage it is hereby agreed that the whole of said Mortgage
