

following children to whom the said Lands described as tenants in common to wit: 1<sup>st</sup> John Harley a son who married Ella — and who now resides in the State of Pennsylvania.

2<sup>nd</sup> George W Harley a son who married Ann Fice and who resides in Frederick County Maryland.

3<sup>rd</sup> Henry F Harley a Son, One of your Complainants who resides in Frederick County Maryland.

4<sup>th</sup> Josephus S Harley a Son, One of your Complainants who resides in Frederick County Maryland.

5<sup>th</sup> Mary A, a daughter now the wife of P. Fulton Willard both of whom reside in Frederick County State of Maryland.

6<sup>th</sup> Cornelius F Harley a Son whose residence at this time is unknown to your Complainants but whose is a non-resident of the State of Maryland.

Your Complainants further charge that the said Lands of which the said Otto F Harley died seized and possessed cannot be divided without loss and injury to the said parties interested and that it will be to the interest and advantage of all the parties concerned that the Real Estate in the proceedings mentioned be sold under and by notice of a decree to be passed by your Honorable Court and the proceeds of sale be divided among the parties interested according to their respective rights. Your Complainants further state that by Articles of Agreement and lease entered into on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November in the year 1871 the said Otto F Harley leased to your Complainants his two farms fully described and mentioned aforesaid in this Bill in the Exhibits herewith filed for the space of two years, commencing on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1872 and ending on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1874 at an annual rent of One thousand dollars payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January in the years 1873 & 1874 all of which will more fully and at large appear by reference to the lease herewith Exhibited marked Exhibit No. 30. To the end therefore that the Defendants hereinafter named may answer the matters and things herein stated the same as if they were herein again repeated and they were thereunto specially interrogated and that the Real Estate mentioned in these proceedings may be sold for the payment of the claims of your Complainants with all interest due thereon and for the payment of all the claims of all the other creditors of the said Otto F Harley who may come in and contribute to the expenses of this Bill and also that the said Lands may be sold under and by virtue of said decree as the Court shall deem proper in the premises and the proceeds of the sale thereof be divided among all the parties interested according to their respective rights and that your Complainants may have such other and further relief as the nature and Equity of their case may require. May it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainants an order of Publication giving notice to the said John W Harley & Ella Harley his wife and Cornelius F Harley who are non-residents as before stated of the substance and object of this Bill and warning them to appear in this Court in person or by Solicitor on or before a certain day to answer the premises & show
