To the Honorable the Judges of the Sixth Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland in and for the Circuit Court for Frederick County, in Equity

The Bill of Complaint of John C. Boteler and Elizabeth C. Boteler his Wife of Frederick County, State of Maryland Respectfully shows unto your Honorable Court that sometime prior to the year 1830 a certain James Moberly formerly a resident of the County and State aforesaid died seized and possessed of a certain Real Estate situate in New Market District Frederick County State of Maryland being a farm containing about 204 Acres of Land More or less, all of which will more fully appear by a reference to a certified copy of a deed herewith filed and an original Deed herewith filed, marked respectively Exhibit No 1 and Exhibit No 2 which with all other Exhibits herewith filed and hereafter to be filed your Complainants pray may be taken and considered by your Honorable Court as a part of this Bill of Complaint. Your Complainants further show unto your Honorable Court that the said Real Estate of the said James Moberly who died intestate descended to the Widow Elizabeth Moberly who survived the said James Moberly, and to his three children as follows: John Isaac Moberly who died without issue, Almada Moberly who intermarried with a certain Charles Miles, and Elvira Moberly who intermarried with a certain Henry Smith of G. That each of the said Children held each an undivided third part in the said Real Estate as aforesaid Your Complainants further show unto your Honorable Court that the one third of the said Real Estate the interest of the above named John Isaac Moberly by virtue of a Judgment was sold at Sheriff's Sale and purchased by the Widow Elizabeth Moberly, and by her was by her last Will and Testament a copy of which is herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 3 devised and bequeathed to the two daughters of the said Elvira Smith, Elizabeth C. Boteler one of your Complainants and her sister a certain Eleanor F. Smith who has since intermarried with a
