Your Complainants further shew unto your Honorable Court, that the one third interest of Almada Mottley who intermarried with the said Charles Miles was by them conveyed to a certain Henry Smith of G by deed dated October 5<sup>th</sup> in the year 1830, as will more fully appear by a reference to a certified copy of said deed herewith filed marked Exhibit No 4 and which said interest was by the said Henry Smith of G conveyed to Geo<sup>M</sup> Smith, James W Smith, Elizabeth C Smith and Allanova F Smith by deed dated April 5<sup>th</sup> in the year 1863 as will more fully appear by a reference to said deed, a certified copy of which is herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 1. Your Complainants still further shew unto your Honorable Court that the said Henry Smith of G. is now deceased and that the interest of the said Geo<sup>M</sup> Smith & James W Smith of all kinds whatever in and to the above named and described Real Estate was conveyed to Elizabeth C Smith now Elizabeth C Boteler one of your Complainants and to her sister Allanova F Smith now Allanova Edmondston by deed dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year 1863 all of which will more fully appear by a reference to said deed a certified copy of which is herewith filed marked Exhibit No 5. Your Complainants charge that they are seized in fee of one undivided moiety of a tract or parcel of Land situated in Frederick County State of Maryland and which has been above described containing 204 Acres of Land more or less and that the other undivided moiety of said Land is held by a certain George Q. Edmondston and Allanova F Edmonds his Wife who are both Adults over twenty one year of age and reside in the State of M. And your Complainants further charge that they are desirous of having a partition of said Land made between the parties according to their aforesaid interests and that they have applied to the said George Q. Edmondston and Allanova F Edmondston for that purpose but their reasonable applications in this behalf have been rejected by the said George Q. Edmondston and Allanova F Edmonds his Wife, and your Complainants are advised that there is no redress except by an appeal to your Honorable Court. For the end therefore that the said George Q. Edmondston and Allanova F Edmondston his Wife may answer the premises and that a decree may be passed by your Honorable Court for a partition of said Land between the said George Q. Edmondston and Allanova F Edmondston his wife and your Complainants according to their respective interests as before stated and that your Complainants may have such further or other relief as the case may require. May it please your Honorable Court to grant unto your Complainants the Writ of Subpoena against the said George Q. Edmondston and Allanova F Edmondston of the State of \_\_\_\_\_ commanding them to appear in this Court at some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed thereon and your Complainants will ever pray &c.
