

liberated by me, and kept in my employment as a hired servant;
Sixthly, - It is my will and desire, that the two Feather Beds and furniture left
in my possession by my Daughter Elvira Smith be delivered to Henry Smith at my
death as they are no part of my Estate,

Seventhly, - It is my will and desire, that all the residue of my Estate be sold by
my Executor and the proceeds be equally divided, that is to say, one third share to
my Daughter Almida Miller, one third share to my four Grandchildren, the children
of my deceased Daughter Elvira Smith and the other one third share to my son John
Dana Nobberly, upon the condition, that the said John Dana Nobberly shall put
up any claim against my Estate, otherwise he to have all benefit of the aforesaid
bequest and it is further my will and desire, that my Executor shall permit my
nephew Isaac Quimby, to select a Master for himself, and he is hereby authorized
to sell him to such Master as he may select upon such terms as he may deem just
and right.

Lastly, - I do hereby constitute and appoint Charles Worthington of James, Executor
of this my last will and Testament, looking all others passing and confirming
this and none other as witness my hand and seal this thirty first day of July
Eighteen Hundred and forty seven.
