having regard to quantity and quality and to allot and assign one of the said
parts of the said land to the Complainant Elizabeth C. Potter, and to allot
and assign one of the said parts of the said land to the Defendant Cleora J.
Edmondson; and that the said Commissioners make out or cause to be made out
a Plat and Certificate of said land and of the Division thereof with the begin-
ning and course and accurate Description of said Estate and of the said parts
thereof and to the said Commissioners then shall be annexed the usual Oath of
Office

Know ye, that we have pursuant to an order of the Circuit Court for said
County sitting as a Court of Equity (Taped on the tenth day of
March A.D. 1874, in a cause begun between John C. Potter and Elizabeth
C. Potter Complainants vs. George J. Edmondson and Cleora J. Ed-
mondson Defendants authorized and empowered you as Commissioners (having
first taken Oath) to make a Partition of the Real
Estate in the foregoing in this case mentioned between the Complainant Eliz-
abeth C. Potter and the Defendant Cleora J. Edmondson, and to the
end that this Court may be enabled to make such Partition it is adjudged
ordered and decreed that you the said Joseph Wood Lebbus Griffith Eli
Davis George Windly Jr. William C. Salmon or any four or any three of you
are authorized to enter upon walk over and survey the said lands and to
divide the same into two equal parts having regard to quantity and quality
and to allot and assign one of the said parts of the said land to the Complainant

And after you shall have entered upon walked over surveyed and divided the
said land as aforesaid you the said Commissioners shall make out or cause

tion of the Real Estate aforesaid and of the several parts thereof All of which
proceedings together with the Plat's Certificates and descriptions had made
or caused to be made Circuit Court without delay
