



Remarks

A representation of the beginning of the Part called "The Resurvey on Four Tracts" lines No. 1 to 13 is also the beginning of Mrs. Jno. Potlow's award lines of which are shaded Green No. 1 to 13. D. The Beg. of Mrs. Eleanor F. Edmondston's award lines of which are shaded yellow and No. 1 to 15. D is a Dugout or inlet 16 1/2 ft. wide for the use of 2 1/2 Cattle

By the request of Joseph Wood Lebeys Griffith Cole Sans William, Salomon Sayd George Hendley Jr. Commissioners acting under and by authority of a Commission issued by the Circuit Court of Frederick County, I have carefully surveyed the lines of the tract in said Commission and run the dividing lines according to the instructions of the Commissioners and also calculated the quantity of land in each Union and made a plat of the same giving the Courses and Distances with some remarks. I also certify that in surveying said lands I found that the 6th line in the survey marked Exhibit J, D. to be erroneous and also the measurement of the 18th and 19th lines, which caused a difference in the quantity of land I make and the survey marked Exhibit J, D. of about 1 1/2 acres

Courses and Distances of Division No. 1.
 Part of a tract of land called "The Resurvey on Four Tracts." Beginning for the outlines at a large stone standing at the end of 104 perches on the 6th line of said land. It also being the end of 104 perches on the 4th line of the Resurvey on Tracts Delight and thence with the 6th line of The Resurvey on Four Tracts enclosing the courses and distances to agree with the Original location S 3° W. 36 perches to a stone N 82 1/4° W 75 1/4 perches to a stone S 26 3/4° W 18 1/10 perches to a stone
