

which I purchased of John Lane and one hundred and thirty seven part of Griffiths Burg to be laid off easterly of my dwelling and to include the Lands on the river around the little Meadow and the Lands over the Hill East of my house to him and his heirs forever in fee;

Item: I give and devise unto Walter my fourth son my dwelling plantation a part of Griffiths Burg three hundred acres to include Buildings and improvements to him and his heirs forever in fee, excepting a single life Estate to Louisa as a home.

Item: I give and devise to my three daughters Elizabeths wife of Thomas Griffith, Mirah wife of Samuel Riggs and Louisa the former whom Ruth Griffith widow of Samuel Griffith Eighty eight Acres of which I selected of his Real Estate and three hundred and fifty Acres to include the where John Laman, Thomas Hilton Jr, and Edward Bens old place with fifteen Acres more of Woodland to be attached to each of the farms where Leamon and Hilton resides, making four hundred and twenty eight Acres to them and their heirs forever those Lands are John and Catharine part of the Resurvey on Mores Delight and part of Griffiths Burg to shear and shear alike.

Item: I give to my unfortunate daughter Rachel W Griffith the sum of one dollar in full of all claims in or to my Estate whatsoever real and personal.

Item: I give unto my son Lyde one hundred and fifty Acres to include the Buildings where Benjamin King now lives in trust together with nine negroes to wit: Moriah, Charlot, Kitty, Plater, Paula, Samuel, Eliza, Anna and William in trust for his sister Rachel the One hundred and fifty Acres of Land for her only use and benefit and none other person to have any control over it and after her decease to go to her heirs in fee tail.

Item: I give to Louisa, Charles and Walter as they are named, choice of One horse, Cow and calf, Six hogs, Six sheep, one Bedstead and furniture each.

Item: All the rest and residue of my Estate to be equally divided between my seven children Henry, Lyde, Charles, Walter Elizabeth, Mirah, Louisa, the negroes with Henry, Lyde, Betsy and Mirah to come into the common stock share & share alike

Item: I give to my grand son Lyde the sum of two hundred dollars to be paid to him at age.

Item: I give and devise unto my son Lyde the sum of One thousand — in trust and to hold it in his own hands for the use and benefit of his sister Rachel and part or price to any other person in case of her decease then to her children when at age.

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my Son Lyde sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament revoking and annulling all former Wills by me made ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last Will and Testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this first day of June Eighteen hundred and thirty six.
