Grimes residents of Frederick County, John Brown and Mary B. Brown his wife, George W. Wick and Margaret A. Wick his wife William S. Cratts and Harriet L. Cratts his wife, Alfred P. Whitshew and Sophia J. Whitshew his wife, Charles F. Knudollar and Martha A. Knudollar his wife and William Glavin Grimes who reside in Carroll County in the State of Maryland commanding them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on a day to be therein named to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein and further to order and direct a commission to be issued to Commissioners to assign Guardian ad litem for said infant William Glavin Grimes to take his answer to this Bill of Complaint and return the same to this Honorable Court, and may it further please your Honors to grant that an order of Publication may be given, your Complainants giving notice to Henry Little and Orphelia Little his wife, now residents of the State of Maryland of the object and substance of this Bill of Complaint and warning them to be and appear in your Honorable Court either in person or by Solicitor on or before a certain day to answer the premises and show cause if any they have why a decree should not be passed as prayed

This Indenture made this 4<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord 1833 between Richard McDermott and his wife Jane of the one part and Levi Grimes and Wilson S. Grimes of the other part all of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth that the said Richard McDermott and his wife Jane for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty Dollars current money to them in hand paid by the said Levi Grimes and Wilson S. Grimes before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said Richard McDermott and Jane his wife doth hereby acknowledge and from every part and parcel thereof doth hereby acquit, exonerate and discharge the said Levi Grimes and Wilson S. Grimes their heirs executors and administrators they the said Richard McDermott and Jane his wife hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Levi Grimes and Wilson S. Grimes their heirs and assigns all that part of a tract of land lying being and adjoining the great Road leading from Summitburg to Fancytown and lying on the South side of said Road adjoining the Lands of Jacob Grise and Christian Correll being part of the Land conveyed to the said Richard McDermott by deed from Isaac
