

Expenses connected with the execution of said trust and retaining for themselves a Commission of Six per. cent and upon the further trust to pay to Saville White the sum of Two hundred and Fifty dollars in Lien of her dower in the Real Estate, and upon further trust to apply the residue of the trust funds in payment of the several debts due to the creditors aforesaid of the said Frederick White per se, all of which will more fully appear by reference to a certified copy of the deed of trust here-with Exhibited marked Exhibit No. 1 which your Trustees pray with all other Exhibits may be taken as part of this their Report of Sale. Your Trustees further report that after giving bond with approved security according to Law they proceeded to execute the trusts vested in them by said deed. Your Trustees report that they sold the Store Goods conveyed by said deed of trust for the aggregate sum of Eleven hundred and Twenty five & 1/100 dollars, they further report that they sold the Pots, Pans and Lumber for the aggregate sum of Four hundred and Sixty one dollar and Fifty three cents (\$461.53) as appears by Statement marked Exhibit No. 2, and that they sold the the House hold and Kitchen Furniture and old Buggy for the aggregate sum of One hundred and Forty six dollar and Twenty cents as appears by Exhibit No. 3 (\$146.20). Your Trustees further report that they have collected the debts due and owing to the said Frederick White amounting to the aggregate sum of Fourteen hundred and Twenty four dollar and Fifty four cents as appears by Exhibit No. 4. Your Trustees further report that they sold at Private Sale the Dwelling House and Lot then and now occupied by said Frederick White being a Two-Story weather boarded House situate on the North side of Main Street in Mechanstown Frederick County Maryland adjoining the property of Dr William White and William Lepton and all the right title and interest of Frederick White therein, and subject to the Vendor's Lien due William Lepton to James Dr White at and for the sum of Six hundred dollars One half of the purchase money to be paid in cash the residue in one year from the 20th day of June 1874 the day of Sale to be secured by note with approved security bearing interest from the day of Sale. Your Trustees further state that they have paid Taxes and expenses connected with the execution of this trust to amount of \$169.68 as well appears by Exhibit No 5 with the Vouchers, and your Trustees bring into Court the Trust Funds as appears by Statement Exhibit No. 6, returned by them to be distributed under the order of this Court all of which is respectfully submitted
