This indenture made this 19th day of March in the year of our Lord 1841 by & between John H. McAlfresh of Frederick County & State of Maryland of the one part & Anthony Kimmel of the same County & State of the other part Whereas by a decree of Frederick County Court sitting as a Court of Chancery bearing date the 19th day of February in the year 1835 & made in case wherein Thomas Mullins and others Complainants and Joshua Mullins and others were Defendants the above named John H. McAlfresh was appointed Trustee and authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of certain Lands & Tenements which by the said decree, decreed to be sold and whereas in pursuance of the said decree the said John H. McAlfresh did on the 8th day of August in the year 1835 sell and dispose of to the said Anthony Kimmel the Lands & Tenements which by the aforesaid decree were decreed to be sold at and for the sum of Two dollars and Fourteen cents per acre making the aggregate sum of the purchase money to be Two hundred and Forty four dollars and Five cents. And whereas the whole of the purchase money for the said Lands and Tenements hath been fully paid and satisfied and the said John H. McAlfresh is authorized by the said decree to execute a conveyance for the same. Now this indenture Witnesseth that the said John H. McAlfresh in consideration of the above recited premises and also of One dollar current money to him in hand paid by the said Anthony Kimmel the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold released aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell release in full and confer unto the said Anthony Kimmel and his heirs forever all those Lands and Tenements situate and lying in Frederick County aforesaid which are contained within the corners and distances to wit: Beginning at the end of One hundred and Eighteen perches on the thirty second line of the whole tract of Land called "Pretty Place" and running South 40° West 107 perches. South 30 degrees West 124 perches North 41 degrees West 189 1/2 perches North 34 1/2 degrees West 143 perches to the end of 77 perches to the closing line of the Original Tract of Land conveyed by Joshua Waddington to Thomas Mullins by deed recorded in Liber W. R. 14 folio 523 &c one of the Land Records of Frederick County aforesaid and with the said closing line to the place of beginning, the same being the Lands and Tenements which were decreed to be sold by the aforesaid decree. to have and to hold the Land and Tenements above described with every of the appurtenances unto the said Anthony Kimmel and his heirs forever to his and their only use and behoof and to and for no other use or purpose whatsoever.
