Your Complainant further represents that on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year 1865 the said Lewis B Cader and Catherine Cader his wife conveyed by deed to a certain Ann C Cader part of said Lot or tract of Land together with another Lot a certified copy of which deed is herewith filed as Exhibit B that said other Lot was conveyed by Henry Stever and Susan Stever his wife on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year 1860 by deed to the said Lewis B Cader a certified copy of which deed is herewith filed marked Exhibit C leaving a tract of Land of about one fifth of an Acre of which the said Lewis B Cader died seized and possessed which Lot or parcel of Land is situated on East Street in Frederick City Maryland adjoining the Lots of the said Ann C Cader and Catherine Cader and being so then seized and possessed sometime in the year 1873 the said Lewis B Cader departed this life intestate leaving a widow Catherine Cader aged seventy one years and the following heirs at Law Peter M Cader who has intermarried with Sidney and his wife, Johnathan Cader who has intermarried with Catherine P his wife William H Cader who has intermarried with Eliza his wife Daniel R Cader who has intermarried with B Anne his wife David W Cader who has intermarried with — his wife Eliza C Lewis who intermarried with William H Lewis who has departed this life Anne M Talbot who has intermarried with Joseph H Talbot Rachel L Cader who are children of the said Lewis B Cader and Agnes C Cader Charles C Cader and Addie M Cader the children and heirs at Law of a deceased son named Charles L Cader who departed this life some time in the year 1863 intestate. This Complainant further represents that the said Agnes C Cader Charles C Cader and Addie M Cader are infants under twenty one years of age and that the said Johnathan Cader and Catherine P Cader his wife William H Cader and Eliza Cader his wife Daniel R Cader and B Anne Cader his wife and David W Cader and — Cader his wife are non residents of the State of Maryland and do not reside therein. And this Complainant further represents and charges that the said Lewis B Cader was in his lifetime indebted to your Complainant on a promissory note in the sum of two hundred dollars with interest thereon as will appear by said Note duly probated and passed by the Orphans Court of Frederick County herewith filed as Exhibit D. and being so indebted departed this life as above stated intestate and that said sum of money with interest from its date is still due and unpaid Your Complainant. Your Complainant further alleges and charges that the said Lewis B Cader died ~~leaving~~ indebted and that his personal Estate is wholly insufficient to pay his debts after payment of his funeral expenses the expenses of Administration and the claim of his widow to the amount of property allowed by Law which she has claimed & received as will appear from a certified copy of a prouncement of his personal effects together with a certified copy of the list
