- Peter M. Cader, a witness of lawful age produced upon the part of the Complainant being duly sworn and examined to interrogatories filed with the Commissioner by the Complainant and herewith returned deposes, says to the
- 1st Int: I have known them for some years.
 - 2nd Int: I know Lewis B. Cader he was my father, He died in Frederick County on the 2nd of January 1873.
 - 3rd Int: He left a widow now residing in Frederick City Md. about seventy one years of age.
 - 4th Int: He left children and grand children the children of Charles S. Cader deceased a son surviving him said Lewis B. Cader dec^d. (All the children are of age but the grand children are not) Ezra C. Cader Charles S. Cader and Ada M. Cader children of Charles S. Cader dec^d. are infants under the age of Twenty one years and all reside in Frederick County Md. His children living at his death are Peter M. Cader who intermarried with Sidney A. Murpley who reside in Frederick County Md. Jonathan Cader married to Catharine P. Bradwell residing in Tennessee William H. Cader married Eliza Kelley and resides in Tennessee David R. Cader married Annie — and resides in Tennessee David A. Cader married but name of wife not known and residing in Virginia Eliza C. married to William H. Lewis dec^d. residing in Frederick County Md. Annie M. married to Joseph B. Talbot and residing in Howard County Maryland and Rachel L. Cader residing in Frederick Co. Md.
 - 5th Int: He did, he left personal Estate, Letters of Administration were granted by the Orphans Court for Frederick County Md. upon his Estate to deponent.
 - 6th Int: I look at "Exhibit E" now here shown me which contains the true value of the personal property of the said Lewis B. Cader dec^d.
 - 7th Int: It has been sold but didn't bring the amount of the appraisement because people wouldn't give what it was appraised for although I used every effort to bring the amount of the appraisement but it fell short One hundred and Twenty six dollars & Fifty one cents (\$126.51)
 - 8th Int: They have amount to One hundred & fifty five dollars & five cents (\$155.05)
 - 9th Int: "Exhibit G" contains a true statement of the amount.
 - 10th Int: I did by the permission of the Orphans Court for Frederick County Md. and paid One hundred and Fifty dollars as well appears by "Exhibit G".
 - 11th Int: About One hundred & Forty one dollars & Fifty cents (\$141.50).
 - 12th Int: I look at "Exhibit D" the signature "Lewis B. Cader" attached thereto is in the proper handwriting of the said Lewis B. Cader deceased.
 - 13th Int: He did die indebted to other persons a correct list of which is contained in "Exhibit H" although as appears in "Exhibit G" some of those mentioned in "Exhibit H" have been paid out of the personal Estate but those whose claims don't appear in "Exhibit G" are still due and unpaid.
 - 14th Int: He did, it is situated in Frederick City Md. and is the property described in the Bill of Complaint and "Exhibit A" "B" and "C" filed in this case.
