2^d Int. I was acquainted with said Mary Elder she is dead, she died in April 1852 in Frederick County Maryland I know James Hughes her dead in Frederick County Maryland on the 2^d day of March 1839.

3^d Int. Said Mary Elder left children surviving her as follows:

Anne E married to Edward A Rider who died in 1852 she left two children namely: George E & Thomas J Rider adults & reside in Iowa

James A Elder married to Mary Frances Tyson Margaret A married to Bennett J Tyson deceased and leaving the following children viz: Maria Joseph & Julia Tyson all infants under twenty one years of age and residing in Frederick County Md. Julia P. adult married to Dr. James Bussey and residing in Frederick Co Md. Joseph E Elder married to Harriet Shilling adult & residing in the State of Pennsylvania.

4th Int. Now, I look at "Exhibit No. 1" now hee show me the property therein described in the same Land. All the adults heere have sold their shares in said Land to Isaac C. Schuman and James C. Schuman who compose the firm of "J. S. Schuman & Bros" for Three thousand dollars (\$3000) for the whole interest of said adult heere and including the interest of the infant children of Margaret A. Tyson deceased whose proportion of proceeds of Sales was to be Six hundred dollars (\$600).

5th Int. I was, she is dead she died in Frederick County Md. on the 22nd day of February 1862, Mary E Elder was her mother and Bennett J Tyson was her husband.

6th Int. She left the following children namely Maria Joseph & Julia Tyson all infants under the age of Twenty one years and all reside in Frederick County Maryland. Some are dead.

7th Int. I think so, at the first place the house wasent worth anything it was old and dilapidated and required a large amount to repair it and couldnt be divided because it consisted of a house and Lot and the price agreed to be paid for it was a full price.

8th Int. I look at "Exhibit No. 2". I do, the signatures "Bennett J. Tyson & J. S. Schuman & Bros" are in the proper hand writings of said Bennett J. Tyson and of J. S. Schuman as one of the firm of J. S. Schuman & Bros with the consent of James C. Schuman the signature "Francis W. Laming" attesting the same is in the proper handwriting of said Francis W. Laming whom deponent saw attest the same.
