5th Sub. I was, She is dead, she died in Frederick County Md. on the 23rd day of February 1862. Mary D. Elder was her mother and Bennett J. Tyson was her husband.

6th Sub; She left the following children namely Maria Joseph and Julia Tyson all infants under twenty one years of age and all residing in Frederick Co. Md. Some are dead.

7th Sub. I think so too, the house was worth nothing it was very old and dilapidated and required a large amount of money to put it in proper repair and couldn't be divided as it consisted of a house on Lot, The price agreed to be paid for it was a full price.

8th Sub. I look at "Exhibit No. 2" now here shown me, I do. the signatures "Bennett J. Tyson" and "J. S. Aman & Bros" are in the proper handwritings of the said Bennett J. Tyson and J. S. Aman as one of the firm of J. S. Aman & Bros with the consent of Thomas C. Aman respectively. The signature "Francis W. Lammiger" attesting the same is in the proper handwriting of the said Francis W. Lammiger whom I saw attest the same.

Whereupon there being no other witnesses present to be examined and no further time being required for the production of evidences the Commissioner closed the said Commission and herewith returns the same under his hand and seal on this 8th day of June 1874.
