Dudrow and Albert Dudrow as his only children and heirs at Law all of whom are infants and live in Frederick County that on the 23rd day of June 1874 the said Jacob Anders assigned to your Complainant one of said single Bills dated the 30th day of March 1866 payable Eight years after date for five hundred dollars with interest from date and which is now due and unpaid with interest due from the 30th day of March 1873 and which is filed herewith as Exhibit "C. W. M." that five of the single Bills of Five hundred dollars each secured by said Mortgage (Exhibit No. 1) have been paid and there are still five of them of Five hundred dollars each including said Exhibit "C. W. M." that are unpaid two of which are not yet due as will appear by said Mortgage that the whole of said Mortgage to Nancy Barriek is due and unpaid and your Complainant is advised he is entitled to have said Real Estate sold for the payment of said single Bill and interest. To the end therefore that the said Jacob Anders Paul P. Zimmerman Nancy Barriek Mary Frances Dudrow Char. E. Dudrow Hamilton M. Dudrow Washington J. Dudrow Ella V. Dudrow Clarence C. Dudrow & Albert Dudrow may answer all and singular the matters and things herein before recited fully and particularly and that the said Real Estate or so much thereof as may be necessary may be sold for the purpose of paying the said Mortgage debts and that your Complainant may have all such other and further relief in the premises as the nature of the case may require and to your Honors shall seem right may it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainant - the State of Marylands Writ of Subpoena directed to the said Paul P.
