Your Complainant further states that for a long time prior to the death of said Philip Karn your Complainant at the request of said Philip Karn and for his use and benefit paid all taxes upon the Real Estate of said Philip Karn a statement of which and vouchers therefor will hereafter be filed as additional Exhibits marked respectively Exhibits Nos. 3 to 17 inclusive Your Complainant further states that he expended forty five dollars as funeral expenses which the estate of said Philip Karn should pay and that he has vouchers for the same which he will hereafter file marked respectively Exhibits Nos. 18, 19 & 20. Your Complainant further states that said Philip Karn being indebted as aforesaid unto your Complainant as aforesaid and unto other persons did on or about the 8<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1869 leaving no personal property and no property of any kind except an undivided two thirds interest in the Real Estate described in a deed from Daniel L. Brier and wife to Philip Karn and Thomas P. Karn dated on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of April A.D. 1867 a certified copy of which deed is herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 2. Your Complainant further states that said Philip Karn left no Personal Estate and that consequently no letters of Administration have been applied for or granted. Your Complainant further states that said Philip Karn died intestate leaving the following heirs at Law a son Thomas P. Karn who is an Adult and is the Complainant in this Bill, a daughter Matilda who is now the wife of David H. Willenay both of whom are Adults living in Frederick County a grand daughter Mary Ann now wife of William Mandy both of whom are Adults now residents of the State of Maryland and reside in the State of Pennsylvania said Mary Ann being the only child of Mary a deceased daughter of said Philip Karn who at the time of her death was the wife of George W. House who is still alive is an Adult now resident of the State of Maryland and resides in the State of Pennsylvania a son William H. Karn who is married and the name of whose wife is Elarrisa Karn both of whom are Adults now residents of the State of Maryland and reside in the State of Iowa also the following grand children Reuben Karn Olivia Karn Mary or Minnie Karn and Elizabeth Karn all four of whom are infants under the age of twentyone years and unmarried all of them residing in Maryland except Olivia who is a now resident of this state and resides in Virginia all four of said Grand children being the children of Lawson Karn a deceased son of said Philip Karn the widow of said Lawson Karn still living being Sarah Karn who is an Adult living in Frederick County also the following grand children Carlton Crone who is an Adult now resident of this state unmarried and lives in Utah Territory or elsewhere outside of this state Amanda J. who is now the wife of Theodore H. Brashears both of whom are Adults living in Frederick County and Josephus P. Crone who is an infant under the age of twentyone years and
