

Plaintiff for a number of years prior to the death of said Philip Karn and  
 at his request paid the taxes upon his Real Estate the Vouchers for which are  
 to be filed as Exhibits to the Bill that the Complainant also paid forty five dol-  
 lars as the funeral expenses of said Philip Karn the Vouchers for which are to  
 be filed as Exhibits to the Bill that said Philip Karn being then indebted  
 to the Complainant and other persons died in the year 1869 leaving no  
 Personal Estate and no property except an undivided two-thirds in-  
 terest in certain Real Estate described in a deed from Daniel C  
 Buser and wife to said Philip Karn and the Complainant a copy  
 of which is filed as an Exhibit to the Bill that said Philip Karn  
 died intestate leaving as his heirs at law a son the Complainant - a  
 daughter Matilda now wife of David H. Hillery a grand daughter  
 Mary Ann now wife of William Manby said Mary Ann being a  
 daughter of Mary a deceased daughter of said Philip Karn who when  
 she died was the wife of George W. Howe, a son William Karn the name  
 of whose wife is Clarissa Karn, four grand children Ruben Karn Olivia  
 Karn Mary or Mimmie Karn and Elizabeth Karn children of Lawson Karn  
 a deceased son of said Philip Karn the widow of said Lawson Karn  
 being Sarah Karn three grand children Carlton Crono Amanda J.  
 wife of Theodore H. Brashers and Josephus P. Crono children of Eliza  
 a deceased daughter of said Philip Karn who was married to Conrad  
 Crono also deceased that all the parties are Adults except Ruben  
 Karn Olivia Karn Mary or Mimmie Karn Elizabeth Karn and Josephus  
 P. Crono that all the parties are residents of Maryland except William  
 Manby and wife George W. Howe William H. Karn and wife Olivia  
 Karn and Carlton Crono, The Bill then prays that said interest in  
 said Real Estate be sold to pay the debts due the Complainant and  
 such other creditors of said Philip Karn who may come in and con-  
 tribute to the expenses of this suit that an account may be taken of  
 said debts and for general relief. It is thereupon this 10<sup>th</sup> day of Septem-  
 ber A. D. 1873 by the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of  
 Equity ordered that the Complainant by causing a copy of this order to  
 be inserted in some Newspaper published in Frederick County once a week for  
 four successive weeks before the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October next give notice to the  
 said William Manby and Mary Ann, his wife George W. Howe, Wil-  
 liam H. Karn and Clarissa his wife Carlton Crono and Olivia Karn the  
 said non-resident Defendants of the object and substance of this Bill and  
 warn them to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before  
 the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. 1874 to answer the premises and show cause if  
 any they have why a decree ought not to pass as prayed.
