The Bill of Complaint of George W. B. Shriner of Frederick County State of Maryland respectfully shows to your Honor, that a certain William Stitely of said County being indebted to your Complainant on his promissory note dated on the 14th day of December in the year 1867 in the sum of twelve hundred dollars payable on or before the 14th day of December 1868 with interest from date and intending to secure the payment thereof unto your Complainant did on the 14th day of December in the year 1867 convey unto your Complainant in conjunction with his wife Harriet Ann Stitely all their right title interest and Estate at Law and in Equity of in and to all part of a tract or parcel of Land called the Home Farm situate lying and being about two miles North East of Woodsborough Frederick County Maryland and containing One hundred and thirty two Acres of Land and being the same Land purchased by the said William Stitely from John Ritchie and Nicholas Fogle Trustees at Public Sale on the 12th day of October 1867 and which your Complainant charges is the same Land which was subsequently conveyed to the said William Stitely by John Ritchie and Nicholas Fogle Trustees in No. 3355 Equity by deed dated on the 3rd day of February in the year 1870 and recorded in Liber C. M. Hall folio 679 One of the Land Records of Frederick County and to which said deed of Mortgage there is a condition annexed that if the said William Stitely shall pay on or before the 14th day of December A.D. 1868 to the said Geo. W. B.
