It being part of a tract of Land called the "Reservoir Loopers Alley" recently conveyed to the said Levi Butts by Barbara Fogle & Isaac Fogle by deed which was put for record among the Land Records of Frederick County bearing date the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June in the year 1870 for reference being had to the plat of said survey, for courses distances and bounds beginning for the said part hereby intended to be conveyed at a stone planted at the end of the 5<sup>th</sup> line of said conveyance as per plat aforesaid and running thence with the outlines thereof North 50° East 38 7/10 perches to a stone South 87 7/10° East 71 1/10 perches to a stone South 14 1/2° West 39 7/10 perches to a stone South 68° East 17 7/10 perches to a stone South 16° West 8 7/10 perches to a stone then by a dividing line now made North 73 3/4° West 109 7/10 perches to the beginning containing twenty one Acres of Land more or less and we the said Levi Butts and Amelia Butts his wife do covenant that we will generally warrant the property hereby conveyed.
