 testate and that letters of Administration on his personal Estate have  
 been granted by the Orphans Court for Frederick County, to his  
 widow Lucretia Williar as well as given by a certified copy of letters of  
 administration herewith exhibited marked Exhibit No. 4. Your Complainant  
 further states that the said Sreat Williar left a widow Lucretia  
 Williard living in Frederick County Maryland and the following  
 children to whom the Lands herein before described descended subject to  
 the unpaid lien of purchase money herein before stated due and owing  
 to your Complainant - viz: 1 Samuel Williar a son living in Illinois  
 2 Josiah Williar a son living in Idaho. 3 George W Williar a son living  
 in Illinois. 4 John S Williar a son living in Illinois. 5 David S Will-  
 iar a son living in Frederick County Maryland. 6 Cornelius A Williar a  
 son living in Frederick County Md. 7 Anna Margaret Williar a daughter  
 living in Fred. County Md. 8. Mary Amanda Williar a daughter now  
 wife of Samuel Morehead living in Frederick County, State of Maryland

 further states that Samuel Williar married Sabilla, George W Williar  
 married Malinda C. and live with their husbands in the State of  
 Illinois that Josiah Williar married Sarah A and lives with  
 her husband in the territory of Idaho. that Catharine wife of  
 David S Williar and Harriet wife of Cornelius A Williar reside  
 with their husbands in Frederick County, State of Maryland.  
 To the end therefore that the Defendants hereinafter named may  
 answer the several matters and things herein before stated and that  
 the land and premises herein before mentioned, and described may  
 be sold for payment to your Complainant of his lien for unpaid  
 purchase money with interest thereon as heretofore stated and  
 that your Complainant may have all such other and further re-  
 lief in the premises as the nature and Equity of his case may re-  
 quire may it please your Honors to grant to your Complainant  
 the order of publication giving notice to said Samuel Williar &  
 Sabilla Williar his wife Josiah Williar and Sarah J Williar  
 his wife George W Williar and Malinda C Williar his wife and  
 John S Williar who are non residents as before stated of the sub-  
 stance and object of this Bill and ordering them to appear in this  
 Court in person or by Solicitor on or before a certain day to answer  
 the premises and show cause if any they have why a decree ought  
 not to pass as prayed and may it please your Honors to grant
