Williar his wife and John S Williar the non residents having been duly notified by publication to appear to the Bill of Complaint and having failed to appear thereto after publication in the Catholic Banner a Newspaper published in Frederick County once a week for four successive weeks prior to the 6th of June 1874 as ordered by the Court. It is therefore this 13 day of September in the year 1874 by me John A Lyuel Judge and by the authority of the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity adjudged ordered and decreed that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for. But because it doth not certainly appear to what relief the Complainant is entitled it is further ordered and adjudged that a Commission issue to the Commissioners of this Court to take testimony to support the allegations of this Bill.
