The above cause standing ready for a hearing and being submitted the Bill answers Exhibits Order of Publication Interlocutory Decree, Depositions and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered, It is therefore this 29th day of October in the year 1874 by the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity and by the authority of said Court ordered adjudged and decreed that the Defendants forthwith pay or bring into this Court to be paid into the Complainant the sum of two thousand four hundred and sixty eight dollars and forty one cents with interest from the 1st day of April in the year 1873 being the balance of purchase money due for the Land so in the proceedings in this cause mentioned until paid or brought in and the Complainant's costs of suit, and that upon payment of the aforesaid sum of money with interest and costs as aforesaid or bringing the same into Court the Complainant by a good and sufficient deed to be executed and acknowledged according to Law shall convey unto the said Defendants as Children and heirs of said Lereal William deceased in fee simple the Land and premises in these proceedings mentioned and described as sold by said Complainant to said Lereal William and all the right title interest and estate of the said Complainant and of his testator John Harbaugh of C in and to the same And it is further adjudged ordered and decreed that unless the Defendant shall pay or bring into this Court to be paid into the Complainant the aforesaid sum of money with interest and costs as aforesaid on or before the 14 day of November 1874 the aforesaid Land and premises or so much thereof as may be necessary
