

5th I look at "Exhibit No. 1" now shown me the property therein described is the same of which the said Jacob Bragoner died seized.

6th He left a widow named Ann aged about seventy three years in feeble health who is now residing in Frederick City Maryland.

7th He left the following children viz: George H residing in Mexico in the State of Missouri married to Mary Eliza Carlton, William M residing in Pennsylvania & married to Lydia Ann Hull Charles A residing out of the State of Maryland, Anna Mary married to Charles E Knauff and residing in Frederick City Md. Jacob B residing in Frederick City Md, and Alfred C Bragoner married to Elizabeth McGee and residing in Frederick County Md. all Adults.

8th Jacob Bragoner is of unsound mind and is now in "Montevue Hospital"

9th It will not admit of advantageous division among the parties concerned, it is not practicable as it consists of a house and Lot in Frederick City Md.

10th It would be to the advantage of all parties interested that said property should be sold and the proceeds thereof distributed among the parties entitled as it will be necessary to sell said property to pay the claims against said estate, when all claims are paid there will be very little left I am the Administrator of Jacob Bragoner deceased and have a claim of about eight hundred dollars (\$800.) against said Estate and nearly equal to the value of the whole estate.

5th I look at "Exhibit No. 1" now here shown me, John Bragoner died seized and possessed of the property therein described.

6th He left a widow named Ann aged about seventy three years in feeble health and resides in Frederick City Md

7th Jacob Bragoner left children as follows George H married to Mary Eliza Carlton and residing in Missouri, William M married to Lydia Ann Hull and residing in Pennsylvania Charles A residing out of the State of Maryland Anna Mary married to Charles E Knauff & residing in Frederick City Md. Jacob residing in Frederick County Maryland and Alfred C Bragoner married to Elizabeth McGee and residing in Frederick County Md. all Adults.

9th It will not admit of advantageous division a division is not practicable as it consists of only a house & Lot in Frederick City Maryland.

10th A sale would be advantageous as it is necessary to sell said Real Estate to pay claims against said estate of Jacob Bragoner deceased.
